Broadcast Journalist

Since finishing his university studies in history and journalism in 2000, Urs Gredig has been working as a journalist, starting his career as a news journalist and presenter for the most popular Swiss private radio "Radio 24". In 2003 Urs Gredig was hired by Swiss National Television SRF where he first worked for sports and entertainment shows before moving to the news department. For seven years Gredig worked as main anchor of the daily news program "Tagesschau". During that time he has been covering numerous political and economic events – such as the world economic forum in Davos – as a special correspondent. As a news anchor he has presented many special programs, e.g. the US election, the Italian election or most recently the special broadcast of the Japanese earthquake and the turmoil in North Africa.

From 2013-2017, Gredig was UK and Ireland correspondent for SRF, based in London, where he covered amongst many other things the Scotland Referendum, two general elections and the Brexit referendum.

Since 2017 he's the Editor-in-Chief of CNNMoney Switzerland, the country's first nationwide TV and digital channel dedicated to business news for and about Switzerland.
