She founded Bye Bye Plastic Bags 2013 at the age of 10 with her older sister Melati, then 12, and has been supporting the movement driven by youth since. The biggest clean-ups in Bali in 2017/18 and 19 became a legend under the umbrella of the people's movement One Island One Voice.

Isabel has spoken on world stages such as TED, United Nations and Our Oceans Conference.

She has also been selected as FORBES top ten most inspiring women in the country in 2017. Isabel and her older sister were awarded CNN HEROES Young Wonders 2018_in Dec in NYC and are named amongst the Top 25 Most Influential Teenagers of 2018 by TIME`s .

Isabel is in 11th grade at Bali's Greenschool and will graduate high school next year.
